A deposit is payable at the time of booking and the balance is due two months (India three months) prior to the departure date. When a booking is made less than two months (India three months) prior to departure, payment is due in full at the time of booking. Telephone and email bookings will be accepted, subject to receipt of the appropriate payment within seven days. Payment may be made by BACS (preferred – please email for Bank details), cheque or Paypal.

DISCOUNTS

For any **two events** booked* and **paid in full** by 15 October 2013, 2.5% may be deducted from the total cost of Photo Holidays and 5% from workshops. For **three events** or more, **paid in full** as above, 5% may be deducted from Photo Holidays and 10% from workshops. (*excluding Picture Forum days)

IMPORTANT - CANCELLATION POLICY & CONDITIONS*

Quest endeavours to be sympathetic when unavoidable cancellations are made, but unfortunately, the past year has seen a significant increase in these, often at short notice. This has resulted in problems with some workshops as it has not always been possible to find late replacements, and on occasion this has meant that running the event was not viable. Conditions for bookings in this programme are therefore as follows:

1. Cancellations made before 3 calendar months* of the event - choice of repayment in full or a credit note. However, any disbursements already made by Quest, or which are due to be made, for travel and/or accommodation and which cannot be recovered, will be deducted.
2. Cancellations made within 3 calendar months of workshop or trip* - credit note or refund issued for all moneys paid **if space can be filled**. If it cannot, deposit will be retained, but any balance will be refunded or credit note issued. However, any disbursements already made by Quest, or which are due to be made, for travel and/or accommodation and which cannot be recovered, will be deducted.
3. Cancellations made within 2 calendar months of event – deposit may be retained at the discretion of Quest, but any balance repaid or credit note issued **if space can be filled**. If space cannot be filled, all moneys will be retained. However, any disbursements already made by Quest, or which are due to be made, for travel and/or accommodation and which cannot be recovered, will be deducted.
4. For any workshop cancelled by **Quest**, all moneys will be refunded - or, if preferred, a credit note issued. Any disbursements already made by Quest, or which are due to be made, for travel and/or accommodation and which cannot be recovered, will be deducted.

In view of the above, you are strongly recommended to take out travel insurance when booking Photo Holidays. *

CANCELLATIONS or CHANGES TO ADVERTISED DATES

Occasionally, due to unforeseen circumstances, it is necessary to change the date of a workshop. As much notice as possible will be given, but if the new date is unsuitable, your moneys will be refunded in full, or a credit note issued. Very occasionally, a workshop has to be cancelled due to insufficient bookings. In this event all moneys will be refunded.

INDIVIDUAL & GROUP TUITION, including CAMERA CLUBS

Quest is very happy to undertake personal tuition, by arrangement, for darkroom printing and some other subjects. This can be on a 'one to one' or small group basis, and can take place either at West Mersea, or in your own home (travel expenses required). The advantage of this is that the tuition can be tailored to precise needs, with 100% personal attention. Prices from £125 per day (or £20 per hour pro rata) Group tuition is available to small or large parties, such as Camera Clubs, and can be on a 'hands-on' or demonstration basis. He is also a Member of the London Salon of Photography, the Arena Group, the Beyond Group, Eastbourne Photographic Society and United Photographic Postfolios. He is a previous member of the panels for the Royal Photographic Society's Licentiate distinctions, and for Associate & Fellowship in Photographic Printing. He has exhibited throughout the world, gaining many awards and he has been a selector at a number of International exhibitions. He lectures and judges at Camera Clubs throughout the U.K
